



## Design Change Policy

Rev. 0 | Effective September 1, 2016

During the twenty-four (24) month period immediately following the Buyer's purchase of a Product (the "Change Notice Period"), if Advanced Interconnections Corp. ("Seller") intends to discontinue a Product ("Discontinuance"), or make a change to the published specifications of a Standard Product or to the agreed upon specifications of a Custom Product as documented on the Custom Product's CAD drawing (a "Design Change"), Seller shall use commercially reasonable efforts to notify the Buyer and provide a six (6) month period for a last time buy. No Design Change of a Custom Product will be implemented without written approval from the original design-in entity or its current authorized Buyer. Seller's notice of Discontinuance or Design Change shall be in the form of a Product Bulletin for a Standard Product or a confidential Product Change Notice ("PCN") for a Custom Product.

The Seller reserves the right to make design and/or manufacturing changes or discontinue the manufacture of any Product subject to the then current Design Change Policy. The foregoing notwithstanding, ongoing changes to supply chain, facilities, and manufacturing processes that do not affect the published or agreed upon specifications of the Products, are not subject to the Design Change Policy, and will be implemented at Seller's sole discretion and without notice.
